1. The mare shall be halter broke and gentle enough to pick up hind feet.
2. For optimum success a vet check of reproductive system prior to breeding is recommended. We also recommend that all mare owners ultrasound their mare after breeding to check for pregnancy, twins or reproductive problems. Mare should be wormed and have a 4-way flu shot prior to breeding, and we strongly recommend a coggins test.
3. A live foal guarantee is given by the stallion owner. If your colt doesn't stand and suck, you will be entitled to a re-breed the following season. For the live foal guarantee to be in effect your mare must have had no less than 3 Rhino shots and 2 wormings during pregnancy. A vet certification must accompany mare stating cause of foals death and reproductive health of mare prior to re-breeding. If Rhino vaccine is not given, live foal guarantee is void. Please inform us as soon as possible after death of foal. Live foal guarantee is also void if mare changes ownership.
4. The stallion owners agree to do all they can to keep your mare and foals safe, but will not be held responsible for death or injury to your mare or foals.
5. To aid in proper information on stallion breeding report, a copy of the mare's registration papers needs to be furnished before mare leaves the premises, stating current owner at time of breeding.
6. In the event that the mare or foal should require the services of a veterinarian while in our care, the cost of those services will be the responsibility of the mare owner.
7. The mare owner fully understands the inherent risks associated with owning, training, boarding and breeding horses. The mare owner agrees to indemnify and hold the stallion owners blameless from any claim, liability, illness or injury incurred by the mare or foals, or mare owner or their charge while on the breeding facility.
